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### **Course Overview**

Advancement Via Individual Determination (AVID) is an elective class where students will develop and reinforce attitudes, skills, and knowledge to successfully enter and complete advanced class work. Students will learn and apply study skills and learning strategies to improve performance in all classes. We will also be participating in team building exercises to help the students set future goals that they can achieve.
